Option One

The Broadmoor Colorado Spring, Colorado



The Broadmoor is the longest-running consecutive winner of both the AAA Five-Diamond and the Mobil Travel Guide Five-Star awards. It is located on 3,000 lush acres under the shadow of Cheyenne Mountain and offers an award-winning spa, fitness center, two swimming pools, three outdoor hot tubs, one lap pool, 54 holes of championship golf and six tennis courts.



The Broadmoor's 700 guest rooms and suites are located in Broadmoor Main Complex and Broadmoor West Complex. Luxuriously appointed rooms have either a king bed or two double beds, comfortable furniture and elegant bathrooms. Many offer views of beautiful Cheyenne Mountain and the resort's own Cheyenne Lake.

The Broadmoor offers three of the finest championship golf courses in the world. Designed by master golf course architect, Donald Ross, the original Broadmoor Golf Club opened with the hotel in 1918. In 1948, Robert Trent Jones Sr. was hired to design an additional nine hole course. The redesign formed the famed East Course. In 1963, an additional nine holes was added by Jones forming the West Course. In 2005, the Mountain Course re-opened, renovated and reconfigured by Nicklaus Design.
